Distribution boxes use standardized wiring codes and breaker types, such as 1P and 2P, to ensure safe power distribution and compliance with IEC and BS 7671 standards.

Key Components and Wiring Principles

A distribution box (also called a consumer unit or panel board) safely distributes incoming power to multiple circuits using protective devices like MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, and surge protective devices (SPDs) while maintaining proper earthing and neutral connections . Essential components include:

- Main Breaker or Isolator: Disconnects the entire supply in emergencies .
- Busbars: Distribute phase conductors to branch breakers; compatibility with breaker types is critical .
- Neutral Bars (N): Collect return conductors for single-phase and three-phase circuits .
- Earth/Ground Bars (PE): Provide a safe path for fault currents .
- Branch Circuit Breakers: Protect individual circuits from overloads and short circuits .
