Key Components

- Transceivers/Radio Heads: Convert wireless signals into digital data and vice versa .
- Baseband Units: Process and control signal transmission and reception .
- Power Sources: Provide electricity, often with backup batteries or generators .
- Cabling: Connects all components for signal and power transmission .
- Shelters/Equipment Huts: Protect sensitive electronics from environmental conditions
