Aerial Suspension: A type of fiber optic cable known as "aerial suspension" uses high-tension wires stretched between the two ends of the transmission line. These wires are used to facilitate cable installation and to keep the cable lines elevated. Durable aerial hardware for fiber utility and telecom builds, including brackets, straps, J-hooks, clamps, grounding, and mounting solutions for pole line and aerial cable support. These Malleable Iron fittings are used with standard pipe near sidewalks and buildings where there is insufficient. It is important when installing aerial optical fibre cable lengths to make proper arrangement for an adequate extra length of cable at a pole position for testing and jointing. This length at each end of cable must be sufficient to enable construction of joints at a convenient work position and it. ADSS Anchor Tension Clamps are hardware fittings used to securely terminate and anchor ADSS fiber optic cables on poles or towers without damaging the cable.
