A fiber optic distribution box (FOB), also called an optical distribution box, is an enclosure that serves as an interface between feeder cables and distribution cables in fiber networks. Its main purposes include:

- Fiber fixation and splicing to secure and protect optical fibers
 - Fiber termination to connect feeder cables to drop cables
 - Optical signal splitting in some cases, especially when integrated with PLC splitters
 - Providing space to maintain minimum bending radius for fibers, preventing damage or signal loss
- These boxes are widely used in FTTH (Fiber to the Home), FTTB (Fiber to the Building), and other access networks, and can be installed in outdoor, corridor, or indoor environments .
