Role of Relays in Relay Protection

They form the core of relay protection by continuously monitoring electrical quantities like current, voltage, and frequency, and deciding when to trip a circuit breaker to prevent equipment damage or system instability .

How Relays Work

A typical protective relay system includes:

- Current Transformers (CTs) and Potential Transformers (PTs): Measure electrical quantities and provide signals to the relay.
 - Relay Device: Detects abnormal conditions and closes its contacts when a fault is detected.
 - Tripping Circuit: Activates the circuit breaker to disconnect the faulty section .
- Relays can be electromechanical, static, or numerical (microprocessor-based), with modern numerical relays combining multiple protection functions in a single device,...
