Safety Considerations

Connecting a distribution box to a bare wire without proper precautions is extremely dangerous. Bare wires can carry live current, posing a risk of electric shock, short circuits, or fire. All connections should be made using insulated wires of the correct gauge, and the distribution box must be properly grounded to an earth bar to ensure safety .

- **Secure Connections:** Terminate wires using screw terminals, busbars, or terminal blocks. Loose or exposed connections can generate heat and cause electrical hazards .
- **Circuit Protection:** Each circuit should have its own circuit breaker or fuse to prevent overloads and short circuits. The main switch should control the entire distribution box .
- **Grounding:** Connect the bare earth wire to the ground bar inside the box. This ensures that any fault current is safely directed to the ground, reducing the risk of s...
