

Basic Installation Procedures for Optical Cable Junction Boxes

Proper installation of optical cable junction boxes involves careful site selection, precise cable handling, effective sealing, organized cable management, and reliable grounding to ensure network performance and longevity.

Site Selection and Mounting

Choose a location close to the fiber optic transfer point while avoiding direct sunlight, moisture, or areas prone to mechanical damage (). For outdoor installations, ensure the junction box is rated for environmental exposure (IP rating) and mechanical protection (IK rating) (). Mark drill holes with a spirit level, drill, insert dowels, and secure the box with screws. Ensure the location allows easy access for future maintenance ().

Cable Preparation and Handling

Carefully remove the outer sheath of the fiber optic cable to avoid damaging the fibers (). Maintain smooth curves and avoid sharp bends, turn-backs, or pulling over edges (). Use figure-8 loops when laying fiber to prevent twisting, with loop sizes typically 2–4 meters depending on cable stiffness (). For OPGW cables, clean and abrade the cable cylinder clamp and closure ports before feeding fibers through the transportation tube ().
