Overview

Project will be executed through a public-private partnership (PPP), with an estimated investment of R\$ 6 billion Brazil will have its first immersed tunnel, 870 meters long, built under the sea to connect the cities of Santos and Guarujá. The Rio-Niterói Bridge (in Portuguese: Ponte Rio-Niterói), officially the President Costa e Silva Bridge, is a box girder bridge spanning the Guanabara Bay, connecting the cities of Rio de Janeiro and Niterói in the State of Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. It is currently the second longest bridge in Latin. The project is located in the Port of Santos, between the two cities Santos and Guarujá in the state of São Paulo coast, some 80 km south west of the city of São Paulo. The two cities are separated by an approx. 500 m wide entrance channel to the busiest port of Brazil. This project, valued at R\$6 billion (\$1 billion), will create Latin America's first submerged tunnel, addressing a century-old demand for a permanent.
