Cutting Cable Trays

- **Planning Cuts:** Follow manufacturer guidelines for optimal cutting lengths and intervals, especially in modular systems, to ensure proper fit and alignment .

Bending cable trays allows for directional changes and level adjustments:

- **Bend Radius:** Maintain the minimum bend radius recommended for the cables being installed to avoid damage. For most power and instrumentation cables, gradual bends are preferred .
