Types of Cable Trays

- Ladder Tray: Open rung design ideal for heavy cable loads, long spans, and maximum heat dissipation. Suitable for power and solar DC runs. Rung spacing typically 150–230 mm (6–9 inches) to support cables without sagging .
- Perforated (Trough) Tray: Solid bottom with ventilation holes, providing continuous support while allowing airflow. Used where moderate heat buildup is expected .
- Solid-Bottom Tray: Fully enclosed, protects cables from dust, moisture, and electromagnetic interference. Best for sensitive instrumentation or control cables .
- Wire Mesh (Basket) Tray: Lightweight, flexible, and easy to install. Suitable for light cabling and complex routing, often in data centers .
- Channel Tray: Compact, used for short runs or aesthetic applications. Can be ventilated or solid .

Materials and Finishes

- Steel (Galvanized or Stainless): High strength, suitable for industrial environments. Hot-dip galvanization improves corrosion resistance .
- Aluminum: Lightweight, corrosion-resistant, ideal for outdoor or humid environments .
- Non-Metallic (PVC, FRP): Corrosion-resistant, electrically insulating, suitable for chemical or wet environments
