

Cable crimping method at the top of the distribution box



Article Overview

Proper cable crimping at a distribution box ensures a secure, low-resistance connection that prevents overheating and mechanical failure.

Preparation of Cable and Terminal

Before crimping, clean the conductor to remove oxidation or contaminants, especially for aluminum cables, and ensure the wire strands are metallically bright . Use a high-quality wire stripper to remove insulation without damaging the conductor. The stripped length should be slightly longer than the insertion depth of the cable lug or connector, as crimping can elongate the terminal by about 10% . Ensure the terminal and crimping tool are from the same manufacturer to guarantee compatibility and optimal compression .

Crimping Procedure

- Insert the conductor fully into the cable lug or terminal, ensuring all strands are inside the barrel and visible through any inspection slots .
- Select the correct crimping tool: Options include hand tools, hydraulic presses, or powered crimpers. The tool must match the terminal type and size to avoid under- or over-crimping .
- Crimping sequence: For cable lugs, start at the connection side and work toward the cable side. For splices, begin at the center to allow material elongation and prevent cracks .
- Compression method: Use a consistent, controlled force. Advanced techniques lik...
