Types of Signal Cables

Signal cables are designed to carry low-voltage data, audio, video, or control signals rather than power. They include:

- Shielded cables: Feature foil or braided metal shielding to block electromagnetic interference (EMI) and radio frequency interference (RFI), ideal for long runs or high-interference environments ().
- Unshielded cables: Simpler and cheaper, suitable for short distances or low-interference areas ().
- Twisted pair cables: Common for low-level analog signals, reducing crosstalk and maintaining signal integrity ().
- Coaxial and planar transmission lines: Used for high-frequency signals to minimize reflections and power loss ().

Cable Routing and Installation

- Plan the route: Keep cables as short as possible, avoid hot or hazardous areas, and ensure accessibility for maintenance ().
- Avoid power lines: Cross high-voltage lines at right angles to reduce interference ().
- Support cables: Use cable trays, rollers, or conduits to prevent mechanical stress...
