

Cable tray connection parallel elbow

A parallel elbow is a cable tray fitting that allows the tray to change direction while keeping the cable run parallel to its original path, ensuring smooth cable routing and maintaining proper bend radius.

Purpose and Function

A parallel elbow is used in cable tray systems to redirect cables around obstacles or structural elements without altering the overall alignment of the tray. Unlike a standard 90° elbow, a parallel elbow offsets the tray while keeping the cable path parallel to the original run, which is particularly useful in tight spaces or when multiple trays run side by side .

Installation Considerations

- **Bend Radius:** Ensure the elbow maintains the minimum bend radius for the cables to prevent damage or signal degradation. Ladder trays typically allow gradual bends, and the elbow should match the tray's curvature .
- **Support and Load:** Parallel elbows must be supported adequately, similar to straight tray sections. The load class of the tray determines the maximum span between supports, and elbows should not exceed these limits .
- **Material and Finish:** Elbows are available in steel, aluminum, or galvanized finishes. Selection depends on environmental conditions, such as corrosion resistance requirements or indoor/outdoor use .
- **Modular Compatibility:** Use elbows designed for the specific tray system to ensure proper fit and secure connections. Modular systems like ladder trays allow easy atta...
