Article Overview

Cable tray supports must meet load, material, and mounting standards, including wall brackets, trapeze hangers, and center-hung rods, with safety factors per NEMA VE 1 and ANSI/NFPA 70.

Types of Cable Tray Supports

- **Wall-Mounted Brackets:** Installed adjacent to walls, typically using brackets such as B409 or engineer-approved equivalents, providing lateral support for straight tray runs .
- **Trapeze Hangers:** Suspended from ceilings using a minimum 1/2-inch diameter rod, supporting multiple trays in parallel .
- **Center-Hung Supports:** Rods or hangers positioned at the center of the tray span to prevent sagging and maintain alignment .
- **Other Accessories:** Include splice plates, expansion plates, blind-end plates, ladder drop-outs, and barrier strips to ensure structural integrity and cable protection .

Load and Span Requirements

- Cable trays must support a uniformly distributed load over the specified span with a safety factor of 1.5 .
- In addition to distributed loads, trays should withstand a 200 lb concentrated load at the midpoint of the span .
- Load ratings apply to both side rails and rungs, ensuring the tray maintains struct...
