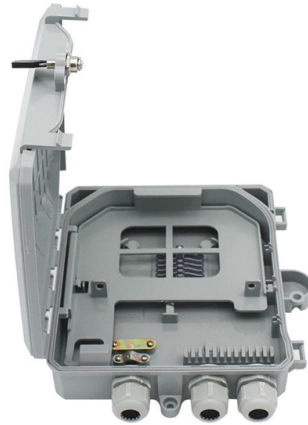


Cable tray division

- **Snap Track Dividers:** These attach to Snap Track trays using patented push pins and can be field-fabricated to fit curves or changes in elevation. They are designed to provide EMI barriers between power and data cables.
- **Divider Kits:** Complete kits include hardware and pre-cut strips for easy installation in basket or wire mesh trays. They are often adjustable to accommodate different cable sizes and tray widths.
