

Cable tray installation in electroplating plant



Article Overview

For an electroplating plant, cable tray installation must prioritize corrosion resistance, proper routing, secure support, and compliance with industrial standards to ensure safety and long-term reliability.

Material Selection

Electroplating plants are highly corrosive environments due to acids, chemicals, and moisture. Cable trays should be made of corrosion-resistant materials such as:

- Stainless steel (preferably 304 or 316 grade) for high chemical resistance .
- Aluminum trays with protective coatings for lightweight and moderate corrosion resistance .
- FRP (Fiber Reinforced Plastic) trays for extreme chemical exposure and high resistance-to-weight ratio . Avoid standard galvanized steel unless it has a high-quality protective coating, as it may degrade quickly in acidic atmospheres.

Tray Type and Design

- Ladder-type trays are preferred for high-power cables because they allow airflow, reducing heat buildup .
- Perforated trays can be used for lighter instrumentation or control cables, providing some ventilation while supporting smaller loads .
- Solid-bottom trays may be used where drip protection is needed, but ensure prop...
