

Cable tray parallel at 70 degrees



Article Overview

When installing cable trays in parallel at an angle, maintain a minimum spacing of 0.6 meters to ensure proper airflow, maintenance access, and safety.

Parallel Tray Spacing

For cable trays installed in parallel, the minimum horizontal distance between trays should generally be 0.6 meters (approximately 2 feet). This spacing ensures adequate room for maintenance, inspection, and heat dissipation, and reduces the risk of cables touching or causing short circuits. If the trays carry both power and signal cables, a minimum separation of 0.5 meters is recommended to minimize electromagnetic interference (EMI), which can be reduced further if the trays are shielded.

Considerations for Angled Installation

Installing trays at a 70-degree angle does not change the minimum spacing requirement, but it affects cable support and stability:

- Ensure that the trays are mechanically supported along the angled run to prevent sagging or stress on cables.
- Use hanging rods or brackets rated for the tray load, especially for ladder-type trays, to maintain structural integrity.
- Verify that the angle does not compromise access for inspection or maintenance, as technicians need sufficient clearance to safely work on the cables....
