Cable trays are available in ladder, ventilated, and solid-bottom designs, fabricated from steel or aluminum, with multiple standards and load ratings to suit industrial, commercial, and data center applications.

Types of Cable Trays

- Ladder Tray: Features side rails with rungs for cable support, ideal for long cable runs and easy maintenance. Cables can enter or exit at any point, making system modifications simple (ABB, Eaton, Hubbell) .
- Ventilated Tray: Solid bottom with perforations for airflow, reducing heat buildup while providing cable support. Suitable for indoor and outdoor installations (ABB, Legrand) .
- Solid-Bottom Tray: Provides full support for sensitive cables, preventing sagging and protecting against dust or debris. Often used in industrial environments (Eaton, Legrand) .

Materials and Finishes

- Aluminum: Marine-grade, corrosion-resistant, lightweight, suitable for chemical and outdoor environments. Forms a protective oxide layer that self-repairs when scratched (Eaton) .
- Steel: Roll-formed structural steel, hot-dip galvanized for corrosion protection. Can be pre-galvanized or coated for indoor/outdoor use. Provides high strength-to-weight ratio (ABB, Eaton)
