Cable Tray Joint Plates

A cable tray joint plate is a metal connector used to join two sections of cable tray, creating a continuous pathway for cables while providing mechanical strength and maintaining electrical continuity for grounding purposes . Joint plates typically have pre-drilled holes through which nuts and bolts secure the tray sections together . Common types include:

- Standard Splice Plate: Joins two straight tray sections end-to-end, clamped with bolts on both sides of the tray rails .
- Coupler Plate for Fittings: Used with bends, risers, or reducers to ensure a seamless transition between sections .
- Adjustable Joint Plate: Allows slight movement to correct misalignment during installation .
- Universal Splice Kit: Includes plates and hardware compatible with multiple tray types, useful for stock management and emergency repairs .
