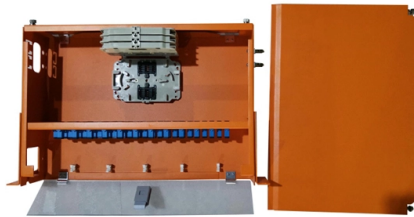


Cable tray welding installation



Article Overview

Cable tray installation involves precise fabrication, welding of support structures, secure bolting, and adherence to safety and electrical standards.

Fabrication and Support Structures

Cable trays are typically supported by mild steel (MS) or galvanized iron (GI) structures, fabricated to match the layout and height requirements of the installation site. Wall-mounted supports often use MS angles (e.g., 50 x 50 mm, 6 mm thick) spaced at regular intervals, usually 1 meter apart, to ensure stability and load-bearing capacity. For longer spans, bridge supports using MS 'C' channels or angle sections are welded to the existing structure to maintain alignment and prevent sagging .

Welding Methods

Welding is commonly used to join support structures and bridge sections. The process involves:

- Arc welding or MIG welding of MS angles and channels to the main support framework.
- Ensuring proper alignment and spacing to maintain the tray's horizontal and vertical levels.
- Welding at intervals of approximately 1 meter for long spans to provide structural integrity .
- Post-welding inspection to verify strength, alignment, and absence of defects....
