

Cable tray width and side height



Article Overview

Cable tray widths typically range from 50mm to 900mm, and heights (side rail depth) range from 25mm to 150mm, depending on cable volume, tray type, and ventilation requirements.

Standard Widths

Cable tray width is the primary factor determining cable capacity. Standard widths vary by tray type and application:

- Ladder trays: 6, 9, 12, 18, 24, 30, 36, 42, and 48 inches (approximately 150mm to 1200mm) are common, with wider trays preferred for large power or solar DC runs to reduce cable stacking and heat concentration .
- Perforated or solid-bottom trays: Typically range from 50mm to 900mm for international projects .
- Width selection depends on the number and size of cables, ensuring proper fill ratio (usually 40–50% of tray cross-section) for ventilation and heat dissipation .

Standard Heights

The height, often called side rail height or tray depth, controls vertical stacking capacity and affects NEC fill compliance and heat dissipation:

- Typical heights range from 25mm to 150mm .
- Increasing depth does not always increase usable capacity efficiently; often, increasing width provides better airflow and easier cable pulling
