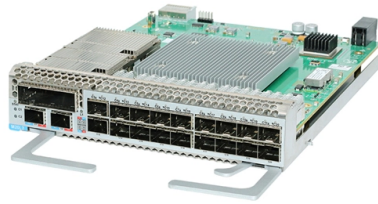


Cable trays on electrical cabinets



Article Overview

Cable trays for electrical cabinets should be installed along walls, ceilings, or directly above cabinets, with proper support spacing and alignment to ensure safe, organized, and code-compliant cable routing.

Recommended Locations

Cable trays are typically installed in the following positions relative to electrical cabinets:

- **Above Cabinets:** Mounting trays on top of electrical cabinets allows cables to enter from above, reducing strain and providing a clear path for distribution to other equipment ().
- **Along Walls:** Wall-mounted trays provide a neat, accessible route for cables, especially in control rooms or server areas ().
- **Ceiling-Mounted:** Suspended trays from ceilings are ideal for long cable runs, keeping floor space clear and minimizing interference with personnel or equipment ().
- **Integrated with Racks:** Trays can be attached to equipment racks or frames, using J-bolt kits or brackets to secure them directly to the cabinet structure ().

Support and Spacing

- **Support Locations:** For optimal performance, support trays at intervals of 1/4 of the span between supports to minimize deflection and stress at splice points ().
- **Load Capacity:** Calculate the total weight of cables and select trays with sufficient...
