Recommended Cable Types

1. Power Cables: These are the primary cables used to transmit electricity within distribution cabinets. They are typically low-voltage cables suitable for phase, neutral, and ground connections. Copper conductors are preferred for their high conductivity, while aluminum is used for lightweight applications. Insulation materials include PVC, XLPE, or rubber, depending on flexibility and environmental conditions .

2. Fire-Resistant and Low-Smoke Halogen-Free (LSZH) Cables: In public or industrial environments, LSZH cables are recommended because they emit minimal smoke and corrosive gases during a fire, ensuring safety for personnel and equipment. These cables are suitable for emergency circuits, public distribution networks, and internal cabinet wiring .

3. Flexible and Control Cables: For interconnections between devices, motors, or frequency converters inside the cabinet, flexible control cables are used. Shielded versions help prevent electromagnetic interference, ensuring reliable signal and power transmission .

4. Modular Connector Systems and Cable Glands: Modern distribution cabinets often use modular connectors instead of fixed wiring. Cable glands are installed at defined entry points to route cables safely into the cabinet while maintaining IP protection. This approach improves safety, reduces installation time, and simplifies maintenance
