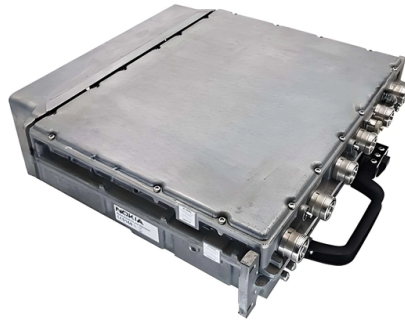


Cambodia s tallest bridge

Cambodia's tallest bridge is the Techo Santephap Russey Chrum Bridge, standing 90 meters high.

Overview

The Techo Santephap Russey Chrum Bridge, also known as Bridge No. 28, is the tallest bridge in Cambodia, reaching a height of 90 meters above the Stung Russey Chrum River . It spans 537 meters in length and has a width of 10 meters, featuring a 15-meter-wide central viewpoint for visitors to enjoy panoramic views of the surrounding forested mountains and river valley . The bridge is located in Chhay Luk Village, O'Som Commune, Veal Veng District, Pursat Province, along National Road 10 .

Construction and Funding

The bridge was constructed by the China Road and Bridge Corporation (CRBC), with technical supervision by Guangzhou Wang An Company . The project cost approximately USD 25 million for the bridge itself, while the broader National Road 10 project received over USD 188 million in funding . The construction overcame significant challenges, including deep foundation excavation, water source protection, and high pier continuous beam construction, using advanced technologies to ensure safety and structural stability .
