

Can a PoE cable be connected to a PoE switch

A PoE switch does not require a special PoE cable; standard copper Ethernet cables like Cat5e or Cat6 can carry both data and power.

Cable Requirements for PoE

PoE (Power over Ethernet) works by sending both electrical power and data through the same Ethernet cable, allowing devices such as IP cameras, VoIP phones, and wireless access points to operate without separate power adapters . Standard copper twisted-pair Ethernet cables, typically Cat5e or Cat6, are sufficient for most PoE applications because they can transmit both data and DC power simultaneously . Fiber optic cables, however, cannot carry electrical power since they use light pulses instead of metal conductors .

Considerations for Cable Quality

While a special PoE cable is not required, cable quality matters, especially for higher-power PoE standards like PoE+ (30W) or PoE++ (60-100W). Poor-quality cables, such as those made with Copper Clad Aluminum (CCA), have higher resistance, which can lead to voltage drops, overheating, and potential device malfunction . Using solid copper cables ensures safe and reliable power delivery.
