A fiber optic gateway can function as both a modem and a router, but if your gateway does not include routing capabilities, you will need a separate router to share the internet with multiple devices.

Understanding Fiber Optic Internet Setup

Fiber optic internet uses light signals transmitted through fiber cables, which are converted into digital data by an Optical Network Terminal (ONT). The ONT performs a role similar to a modem, translating the optical signal from your ISP into a format that devices can use. Unlike cable or DSL, fiber does not require a traditional modem.

Role of a Router

To distribute internet to multiple devices, a router is typically required. The router manages your home network, assigns IP addresses, and provides Wi-Fi or wired connections. While any standard router with a WAN Ethernet port can connect to the ONT, routers optimized for fiber can better handle high speeds, low latency, and multiple simultaneous connections.
