

Can a telecom router connect to fiber optic cable



Article Overview

A standard telecom router cannot connect directly to a fiber optic cable; it requires an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to convert the optical signal into an electrical signal compatible with the router.

How Fiber Internet Works with Routers

Fiber optic internet transmits data as light pulses through glass or plastic fibers, which standard routers cannot interpret directly. To bridge this gap, an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) is installed by your Internet Service Provider (ISP). The ONT converts the incoming optical signal into an electrical signal that your router can use via an Ethernet connection .

Required Equipment

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Converts light signals from the fiber into Ethernet signals for your router .
- Fiber Optic Cable: Connects the ISP's fiber line to the ONT, typically with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- Router: Must have a WAN or Ethernet port to receive the signal from the ONT. Some routers are fiber-ready with SFP ports for direct fiber input, but most home routers use Ethernet .
- Ethernet Cable: Connects the ONT to the router's WAN port to transmit data .
