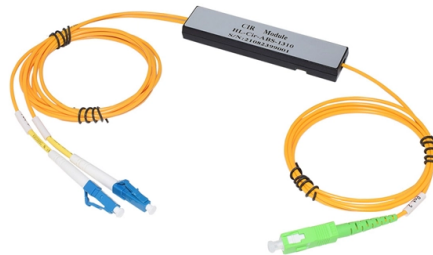


Can an SFP optical module be used

An SFP optical module is used to connect network devices to fiber optic or copper cabling, converting electrical signals into optical signals and vice versa for flexible, high-speed network communication.

Core Function

An SFP (Small Form-Factor Pluggable) optical module acts as a hot-pluggable transceiver that converts electrical signals from networking equipment into optical signals for transmission over fiber, and converts incoming optical signals back into electrical signals for the host device . This allows switches, routers, servers, and media converters to communicate over different physical media without replacing the hardware .
