The module defines the optical signal type, while the connector determines the physical interface. Proper alignment of the fiber core with the transceiver is essential for optimal performance . **Adapters and Media Converters:** If the optical cable and interface are not directly compatible, fiber media converters or adapters can bridge the connection. For example, a copper Ethernet interface can be connected to a fiber network using a media converter, allowing optical cables to interface indirectly with devices that do not have native fiber ports . **Installation Best Practices:** Always clean connectors before insertion, inspect cables for damage, and avoid bending beyond the recommended radius to...
