Single conductor cables and Type MV cables must be installed in ladder or ventilated trough cable trays. Single conductor cables and Type MV cables are not allowed to be installed in solid bottom cable trays [1993 NEC Section 318-3 (b)] In Class II, Division 2 Hazardous (Classified) Locations. Cable tray is the preferred wiring method for industrial facilities, data centers, and large commercial buildings where routing dozens or hundreds of cables through individual conduits would be impractical and expensive. NEC Article 392 governs cable tray installations, covering tray types, fill. Choose a cable tray or ladder that is compatible with the cables and can provide adequate support and protection against mechanical stress, environmental factors, and electromagnetic interference (EMI).
