

# Can shielded cables be run in cable trays



## Article Overview

Shielded tray cables are compatible with most cable trays, especially solid-bottom or enclosed trays, to minimize electromagnetic interference (EMI) and ensure reliable signal and power transmission.

### Shielded Tray Cables

Shielded tray cables include a conductive layer, such as corrugated or flat copper tape, that protects against EMI from nearby electrical equipment, power lines, or industrial machinery . Corrugated shields offer flexibility and external EMI protection, while flat shields provide superior EMI protection both inside and outside the conductor core, making them ideal for sensitive applications like variable frequency drives (VFDs) or areas with high voltage fluctuations . These cables are typically rated for TC (Tray Cable) or TC-ER (Tray Cable, Exposed Run) standards, allowing installation in cable trays, ducts, conduits, or even direct burial .

### Cable Tray Types and Shielding

The type of cable tray affects EMI protection:

- Solid-bottom trays: Provide strong shielding by blocking external EMI, suitable for shielded cables carrying sensitive signals .
- Enclosed trays (trough or channel): Offer the highest protection, fully surrounding the cables and preventing interference .
- Perforated trays: Offer limited EMI protection; shielded cables can still be used, but additional measures like metallic covers or EMI gaskets may be needed .....
