

Can t the fiber optic cable be connected to the router

A fiber optic cable cannot be connected directly to a standard router; it must first pass through an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) that converts the light signal into an Ethernet signal your router can use.

Why Direct Connection Isn't Possible

Fiber optic cables transmit data as light signals, whereas standard routers operate using electrical signals over Ethernet. Because of this difference, a direct connection is not feasible. Attempting to plug a fiber cable directly into a router will not work and could damage the equipment .

Role of the Optical Network Terminal (ONT)

The ONT is a device provided by your Internet Service Provider (ISP) that serves as the bridge between the fiber network and your home network. Its main functions include:

- Optoelectronic conversion: Converts incoming light signals from the fiber into standard electrical signals.
- Ethernet output: Provides a standard Ethernet port to connect your router.
- Signal management: Ensures stable and reliable data transmission from the fiber network to your devices . The ONT is typically installed near the point where the fiber enters your home, often on an interior wall or in a closet....
