Electrical distribution boxes in Mexico must comply with NOM standards and obtain Certificates of Conformity (CoC) from accredited certification bodies to ensure safety and regulatory compliance.

### Regulatory Framework

In Mexico, electrical installations and equipment, including distribution boxes, are regulated primarily by the Comisión Federal de Electricidad (CFE) and the Secretaría de Energía (SENER). Compliance with Normas Oficiales Mexicanas (NOMs) is mandatory to ensure safety, prevent electrical hazards, and guarantee proper operation of electrical systems . - NOM-001-SEDE-2012: Governs the safety and efficiency of electrical installations, including design, materials, and installation practices .
