

Common Thickness Standards for Galvanized Cable Trays



Article Overview

Galvanized cable trays typically use sheet metal thicknesses from 1.2mm to 3.0mm, with zinc coating thicknesses ranging from 12µm for electro-galvanized trays to 45-55µm for hot-dip galvanized trays.

Sheet Metal Thickness

The sheet metal thickness of cable trays depends on the tray type, load capacity, and support spacing:

- Ladder Cable Trays: Designed for heavy power cables over long spans, recommended thickness is 2.0mm to 3.0mm to prevent side-rail deflection and rung deformation under load .
- Perforated Cable Trays: Balance weight and strength, typically 1.2mm to 2.0mm, ensuring cross-sectional stability for standard routing .
- Solid Bottom Trunking & Raceways: Used for sensitive signal lines requiring shielding, usually 1.5mm to 2.0mm to maintain flat tracking profiles . The thickness selection also considers support spacing: wider spans increase bending stress, requiring thicker side rails and deeper profiles to meet NEMA deflection criteria .
