

Communication optical cables and electrical cables on the same pole



Article Overview

Communication optical cables can share a pole with electrical cables if proper separation, cable type, and regulatory guidelines are followed.

Separation and Safety Requirements

When installing communication cables near electrical power lines, maintaining proper clearance is critical to prevent electrical hazards and electromagnetic interference (EMI). OSHA and NESC guidelines specify minimum approach distances based on voltage levels. For example, for overhead lines over 300V but not exceeding 750V, a minimum separation of 12 inches is required, increasing with higher voltages up to 54 inches for lines over 121 kV (phase to phase) to ensure safety and signal integrity . Communications cables should generally be located below power conductors on poles, and they cannot be attached to crossarms carrying electric conductors .

Cable Types and Placement

All-Dielectric Self-Supporting (ADSS) cables are designed for installation near or above high-voltage lines because they are non-conductive and resistant to electrical hazards. ADSS cables use glass-reinforced plastic or other dielectric materials instead of metal, making them suitable for aerial deployment alongside power lines . Standard optical fiber cables must be installed in the telecom space, maintaining proper clearance from electrical cables and other low-voltage lines, including mid-span sag considerations . Sag should generally be limited to less than 2% of the spa...
