Fiber Management and Signal Integrity: Upgraded boxes provide organized cable routing, bend radius protection, and integrated splice trays, reducing signal loss and simplifying maintenance. They also accommodate pre-connectorized or fusion-spliced setups, whereas some traditional boxes may only support one method . 4. Deployment Suitability:
