A distribution box safely distributes electrical power to multiple circuits using components like circuit breakers, RCCBs, isolators, bus bars, and surge protection devices.

Key Components of a Distribution Box

Circuit Breakers (MCBs): Protect individual circuits from overloads and short circuits by automatically cutting off power when abnormal current is detected, preventing damage to wiring and appliances . **Residual Current Circuit Breaker (RCCB):** Detects small imbalances between live and neutral wires, providing protection against electric shocks and leakage currents. Often installed alongside MCBs for enhanced safety . **Isolators / Switches:** Manually operated devices that allow electricians to safely disconnect a circuit for maintenance. They ensure that parts of the system can be worked on without risk of electric shock . **Bus Bars:** Metal strips that conduct electricity within the box, serving as central connection points for all outgoing circuits. They include neutral links for return current and grounding bus bars for safety . **Surge Protective Devices (SPDs):** Protect the system from voltage spikes caused by lightning or phase-to-phase faults, preventing damage to sensitive equipment . **Enclosure:** The outer casing made from durable materials like polycarbonate, ASA, or epoxy-coated stainless steel, protecting internal components from dust, moisture, and physical damage . **Indication Lights:** Provide visual status of mains power supply, helping users quickly identify power availability and faults . **Electrical Wiring:** Includes connections for circuits, sometimes for specialized equip...
