

Concealed wiring in meter boxes and distribution boxes



Article Overview

Concealed wiring can be safely installed using conduit systems, but meter and distribution boxes must remain accessible and free of unauthorized equipment.

Concealed Wiring Techniques

Concealed wiring, often installed within walls or ceilings, improves aesthetics and protects wires from damage. The typical process involves:

- Planning the Electrical Layout – Map out conduit routes and box locations to minimize future maintenance issues and ensure compliance with electrical codes .
- Creating Wall Grooves – Channels are cut into walls to house conduits, which can be PVC (lightweight, corrosion-resistant) or metallic (stronger mechanical protection), .
- Installing Electrical Boxes – Switch, socket, and junction boxes are fixed into wall openings before laying conduits .
- Pulling Wires Through Conduits – Wires are threaded using fish tape, then connected to switches, sockets, fixtures, and the distribution board .
- Testing and Covering – The system is tested for faults, and wall grooves are filled with plaster or cement to fully conceal the wiring .

Safety and Accessibility Requirements

Meter boxes and distribution panels have strict clearance and access requirements:

- Working Space – NEC mandates a minimum of 36 inches in front of the panel, 30 i...
