An optical communication module is an optoelectronic device that converts electrical signals into optical signals and vice versa, enabling high-speed data transmission over optical fiber networks.

Overview

An optical communication module, often referred to as an optical transceiver, operates at the physical layer of the OSI model and is essential for optical fiber communication systems. Its primary function is photoelectric conversion, allowing electrical signals from network equipment to be transmitted as light through optical fibers and converting received light signals back into electrical signals for processing.

Key Components

- **Transmitter Optical Sub-Assembly (TOSA):** Converts electrical signals into optical signals using a laser diode (LD) or light-emitting diode (LED). The TOSA includes an optical interface, monitoring photodiode, housing, and electrical interface. Laser diodes are preferred for high-speed, long-distance communication due to their higher output power and efficiency, while LEDs are suitable for low-rate, short-distance applications.
- **Receiver Optical Sub-Assembly (ROSA):** Converts incoming optical signals back into electrical signals. It contains a photodetector (PIN or avalanche photodiode), a trans-impedance amplifier (TIA), and a post-amplifier. APDs provide higher sensitivity by...
