Choose a suitable location that is dry, accessible, and well-ventilated, typically around 1.5 meters above the floor for easy access . Verify that the box has the appropriate IP/NEMA rating for environmental protection, especially for outdoor or industrial installations . Gather necessary tools such as insulated screwdrivers, wire strippers, multimeter, and torque wrenches .
