

Connection between distribution box and lighting distribution board



Article Overview

To connect a lighting distribution box, feed the main phase and neutral through the isolator and RCCB, then distribute power to MCBs for each lighting subcircuit, ensuring proper earthing and safety.

Step-by-Step Connection Process

1. Main Power Supply Connection The phase (live) and neutral wires from the energy meter are first connected to the main isolator. The isolator acts as the main switch, allowing you to manually disconnect the entire electrical system for safety . 2. RCCB Installation From the isolator, connect the phase and neutral lines to the RCCB (Residual Current Circuit Breaker). The RCCB protects against current leakage and electric shocks by isolating the circuit during fault conditions . 3. Neutral and Earth Distribution

- Connect the neutral wire from the RCCB to the neutral bus bar.
- Connect the earth wire to the earth bus bar, which should be linked to a proper earth pit with an earth rod for safety . 4. MCB Connections for Lighting Subcircuits
- Connect the phase line from the RCCB to the input terminals of the MCBs.
- Each MCB protects a specific lighting subcircuit from overload or short circuits.
- The neutral wires from each subcircuit are connected to the neutral bus bar, and the earth wires to the earth bus bar . 5. Subcircuit Wiring
- Run cables from each MCB to the respective lighting points.
- Ensure the cable size matches the load; for example, 1.5 mm² or 2.5 mm² copper...
