

Cost of cable tray support by weight



Article Overview

The weight of cable tray supports depends on the tray type, material, dimensions, cable fill, and span between supports, and must be calculated to ensure proper load-bearing and accurate pricing.

Key Factors Affecting Support Weight

- **Tray Material:** Steel (mild or galvanized) is heavier than aluminum, while stainless steel is slightly denser than mild steel. Typical densities are $7,850 \text{ kg/m}^3$ for carbon steel, $8,000 \text{ kg/m}^3$ for stainless steel, and $2,700 \text{ kg/m}^3$ for aluminum . FRP or fiberglass trays are lighter, around $1,800\text{--}2,000 \text{ kg/m}^3$.
- **Tray Dimensions:** The width, side rail height, and sheet thickness directly influence the tray's dead weight. Wider and deeper trays with thicker metal require stronger supports and increase cost .
- **Cable Fill:** The number and type of cables installed add to the total load. Supports must be designed to carry tray weight plus full cable payload at 100% capacity .
- **Support Spacing:** The distance between brackets or hangers affects the reaction force on each support. Longer spans increase bending moments, requiring heavier or more robust supports .
- **Tray Type:** Ladder trays, perforated trays, solid-bottom trays, and wire mesh trays have different weights due to their construction. Perforated trays reduce metal content by about 20%, while wire mesh trays are lighter and allow better airflow .
