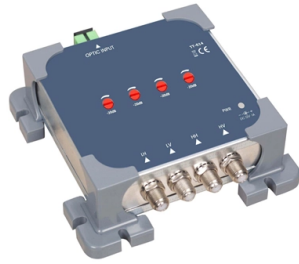


Dimensions of the electrical distribution box in the room

Electrical distribution boxes (DB boxes) come in a range of standard sizes, typically from compact wall-mounted units to larger floor-standing cabinets, with dimensions depending on application, amperage, and device count.

Standard Dimensions

Wall-mounted DB boxes for residential or light commercial use generally range from 200 × 200 × 120 mm up to 800 × 600 × 300 mm (Height × Width × Depth), with intermediate sizes available to accommodate different circuit layouts and spare capacity . Floor-standing or freestanding cabinets are larger, commonly 1600-2200 mm in height, 600-1800 mm in width, and 300-600 mm in depth, suitable for industrial or high-amperage installations . Single-gang and multi-gang boxes are used for smaller installations, such as one or multiple switches or outlets. Single-gang boxes are typically around 2" × 3" × 3.5", while junction boxes often measure 4" × 4" with varying depths from 1.5" to 3.5" depending on wire count and internal volume requirements .

Depth and Internal Volume

Depth is critical for wiring capacity and safety. Deeper boxes provide more internal volume, making conductor splicing, device installation, and cover fitting easier, especially when multiple wires are present . Internal usable space is smaller than external dimensions due to wall thickness, mounting hardware, and bend radius req...
