

Dimensions of the fiber optic box for home entry



Article Overview

Typical residential fiber optic entry boxes range from approximately 205 × 157 × 60 mm to 340 × 235 × 108 mm, depending on model and capacity.

Common Residential Fiber Box Dimensions

- Leviton FTTH Point of Entry Box: Designed for single-family homes and MDUs, it can be mounted inside a Structured Media® Enclosure or directly on a wall. While the exact dimensions are not specified in the datasheet, it is compact enough for wall or enclosure mounting and supports standard fiber termination and staging .
- Melbye MTeH EASY Indoor Fiber Box: Dimensions are 205 × 157 × 60 mm, suitable for 1-24 splices and 1-12 connectors. It supports SC or LC adapters, allows cable entry from multiple sides, and can be used for splicing or patching .
- Melbye TeH MINI / Optical Box SOP 12 (24): Dimensions are 296 × 206 × 108 mm, designed for wall mounting, with capacity for 12-24 splices and up to 4 meters of fiber reserve. It includes pre-molded knockouts and supports flexible installation .
- PPC Universal Fiber House Box: Designed for FTTH installations, it allows standardized mounting of components with open-ended cable ports for up to 1-inch conduit. Exact external dimensions are not listed, but it is compatible with typical residential wall or enclosure mounting .
- Holight HTB8067 24-Port Indoor Fiber Distribution Box: Compact wall-mountable cabinet for FTTH applications, integrating termination, splicing, and distribution. While exact dimensions are not provided, it is designed for indoor use with IP55 protection and front-only access for pull-out tray maintenance
