Typical household electrical boxes in the U.S. range from 2" × 3" × 3.5" for single-gang boxes to 4" × 4" or larger for junction boxes, with depths from 1.5" to 3.5" depending on wire count and device requirements.

Common Types and Sizes

Single-Gang Boxes: These are the most common for one switch or outlet. Standard dimensions are approximately 2 inches wide × 3 inches tall × 3.5 inches deep, providing at least 18 cubic inches of internal volume to meet NEC wire-fill requirements . **Multi-Gang Boxes:** Used for multiple switches or outlets in one location, these boxes are wider to accommodate additional devices. Width increases proportionally with the number of gangs, while depth typically ranges from 2" to 3.5" to allow sufficient wiring space . **Junction Boxes:** Square or rectangular boxes used for wire splices and branch connections. Standard sizes are around 4" × 4", with depths from 1.5" to 3.5", depending on the number of conductors and device size . **Octagonal junction boxes** for ceiling fixtures are usually 4" in diameter with similar depth ranges . **Ceiling and Fixture Boxes:** Round or octagonal boxes designed for ceiling lights, fans, or smoke detectors. Depth is critical for mounting hardware and wiring, typically 1.5" to 3", with diameters around 4" .
