

Disabling routing function on fiber optic routers



Overview

For Cisco routers, follow these command steps: Router(config)#interface [interface-name] Router(config-if)#no ip source-route This command effectively disables IP source-routing across all or specified interfaces, thus preventing potential exploitation. Bridge mode is a router setting that turns off the routing function on one device so another can take full control of your network. It sounds technical, but the reason you might need to use it is straightforward: two devices are both trying to manage the network, and the conflict is causing.
