

Distance between the distribution box and the door edge



Article Overview

A distribution box should be installed at least 600 mm from the edge of an open door in domestic setups, and 1000 mm from lift-off panels or doors in industrial setups.

Recommended Clearances

- Domestic Installations: Maintain a minimum distance of 600 mm from the edge of an open distribution box door to ensure safe operation and accessibility for maintenance .
- Industrial or Lift-Off Panels: For panels with removable doors or lift-off panels, a clearance of 1000 mm is recommended to allow full access and safe handling of the equipment .
- Front Working Space: Ensure at least 0.6 meters of unobstructed space in front of the distribution box for domestic setups, and 1 meter for larger or commercial switchboards .
- Height from Floor: The recommended height for residential distribution boards is typically 1 to 1.8 meters, with 1.3 meters suggested for elderly or handicapped users .

Additional Safety Considerations

- Side and Top Clearance: Provide sufficient space on the sides and above the box to allow for ventilation, wiring, and future maintenance .
- Accessibility: The distribution box should be located in a dry, well-ventilated area,...
