Key Considerations for Jumper Selection

1. Current Rating: Always check the maximum current rating of both the terminal block and the jumper. The jumper may have a lower rating than the terminal block itself, so using a jumper that cannot handle the load can lead to overheating or failure. For example, screw-tensioned clamps with large busbars may support 20–24 A, but the jumper may be rated lower, requiring a purpose-built distribution block for higher currents . 2. Pole Count and Length: Jumpers are available in 2, 3, 4, or 10-pole versions, corresponding to the number of terminal positions they connect. Choose a jumper that matches the number of terminals you need to link. Pre-assembled jumpers simplify installation by combining the link, sleeve, and fixing screw into one unit . Custom lengths can also be cut or modified to fit specific terminal arrangements . 3. Material and Surface Finish: Jumpers are typically made of copper or brass for good conductivity, often tin-plated to resist corrosion. The material choice affects both electrical performance and durability . 4. Compatibility with Terminal Blocks: Ensure the jumper is designed for the specific terminal block series you are using. Some jumpers are manufacturer-specific and may not fit other brands. Internal jumpers are defined within multi-level terminal properties, while external jumpers can connect any two or more terminals . 5. Installation Practices:
