

Distribution box dimensions concealed installation

Distribution boxes should be sized according to circuit load and switch arrangement, installed at 1.5–1.8 meters height in dry, ventilated areas, with proper grounding and IP/NEMA-rated enclosures.

Dimensions

Residential or small power distribution boxes:

- For boxes handling lighting circuits or small power loads with incoming wire size
