

Distribution box thickness



Article Overview

The standard wall thickness for low-voltage distribution boxes is generally 1.5 mm, with metal auxiliary poles at 1.2 mm, though specific requirements vary by material, equipment, and environmental conditions.

Standard Thickness

According to national standards, the wall thickness of a low-voltage distribution box should not be less than 1.5 mm, while the metal auxiliary pole should be at least 1.2 mm to ensure safety and structural integrity . This thickness helps the box safely support electrical equipment and provides resistance against mechanical stress and seismic activity.

Factors Affecting Thickness

- **Equipment and Purpose:** Distribution boxes carrying heavier or more complex electrical components may require thicker walls to support the load and prevent deformation .
- **Material Type:** Boxes made from steel, stainless steel, or aluminum generally require greater thickness than those made from iron sheets or plastic to maintain durability and safety .
- **Seismic Resistance:** In earthquake-prone areas, thicker enclosures improve structural stability and reduce the risk of damage .
- **Temperature Variations:** Materials respond differently to heat and cold; thickness may need adjustment to prevent warping or cracking under extreme temperature changes
